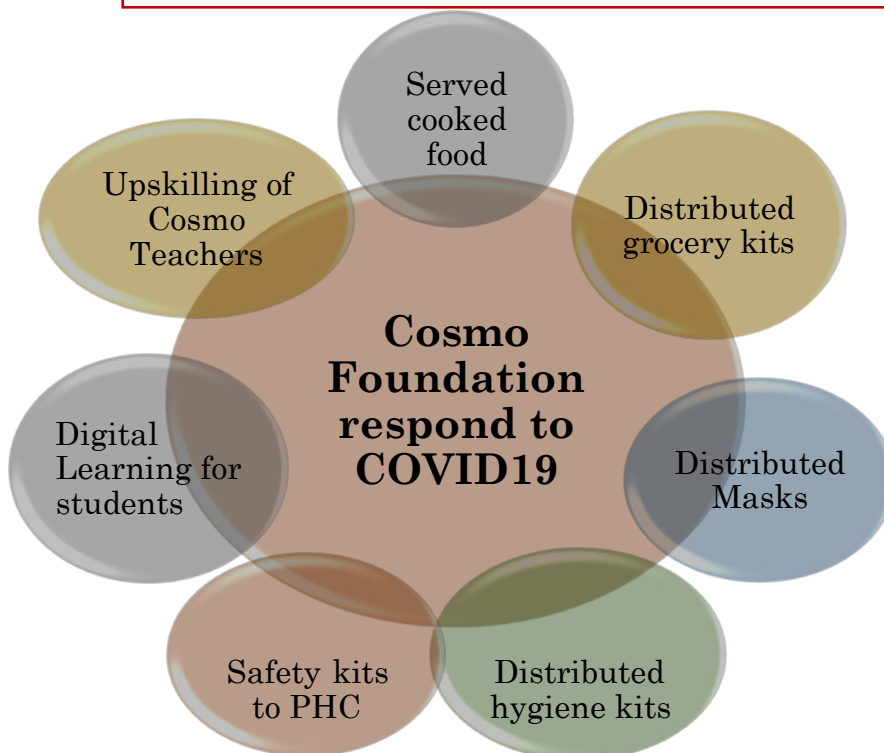
Leading through the Crisis First Wave of COVID-19

Cosmo Films being a leading manufacturer of packaging materials which is required in essential services like biscuits, soaps etc. started its manufacturing units much early (1st week of April) and ensured employability with all safety measures with most human approach. All the measures of health, hygiene, social distancing, safe and secure travel, food arranged for the workers and employees. Grocery kits were distributed to workers.

In the same spirit, Cosmo Foundation initiated a drive to serve food to thousands of people across four states viz. Gujarat, Delhi, Maharashtra, and Rajasthan. Meals and Grocery Kit Distribution

Cosmo Foundation identified vulnerable populations like rickshaw pullers, people in red zone areas, pregnant women, single women, migrant farm labourers and different people living on daily wages across rural and urban locality. In this process, the organization also joined hands with various like-minded agencies working for humanitarian cause and served to the following –

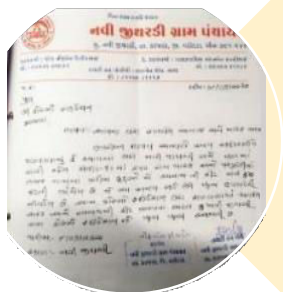

Reaching out to the Stranded Migrant Labourers

Due to imposition of lockdown, the most affected population was migrant labourers. Thousands of them had to walk hundreds of kilometers on feet towards their hometown.



500 Hygiene kits containing sanitizers, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, hair oil, mask, were provided to 130 migrants sheltered Karjan Municipality, police personnel and block magistrate office team at Karjan.



400 migrants families of farm labourers were provided with the grocery kits across 12 villages of Karjan block in Vadodara.



A special bus was facilitated for 26 Migrants labours for their safe home travel from Delhi to Jadgishpur, UP

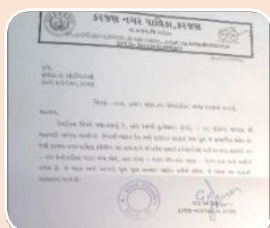

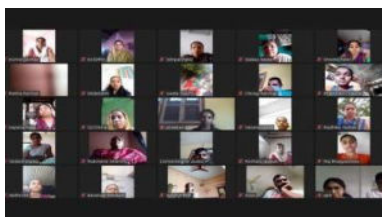

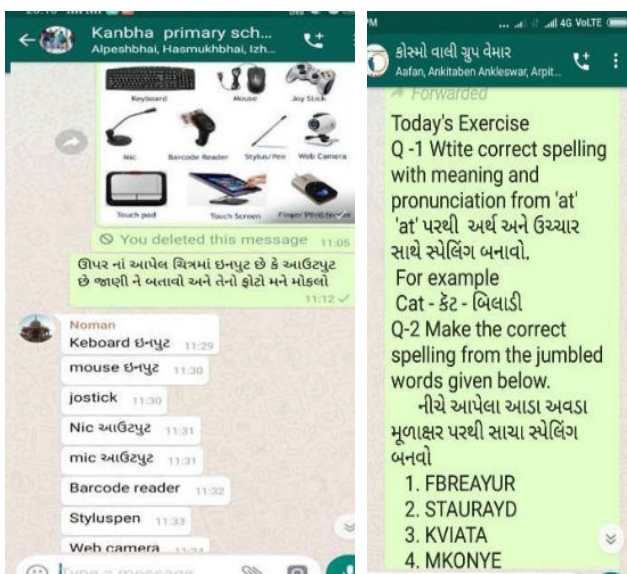

Cosmo Digi Pathshaala

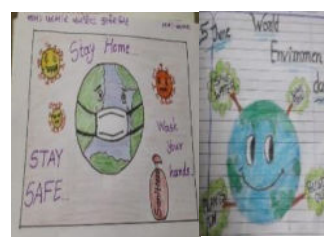

Students prepare and send their videos on English speaking, hygienic practices, and their joyful participation on various days under the guidance of Cosmo teachers. They started adapting to access different video editing applications. In turn they are sending audio video answers with full-fledged confidence. Various home-based activities are carried out viz, making paper bags, masks, photo frames, etc. In some location students call their respective teachers for extra home work.

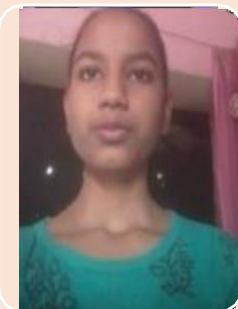

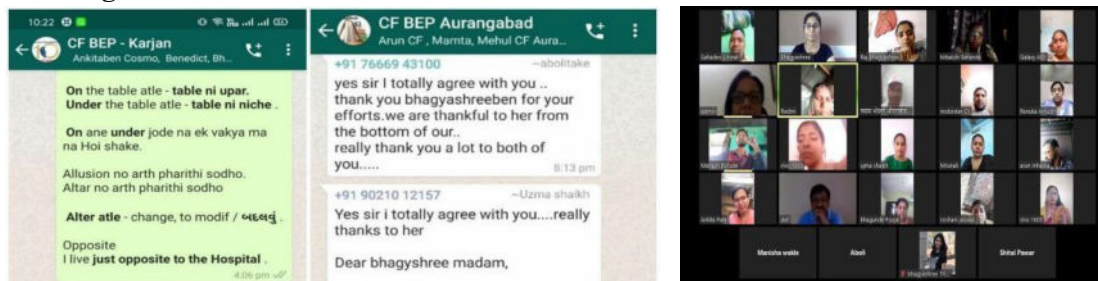

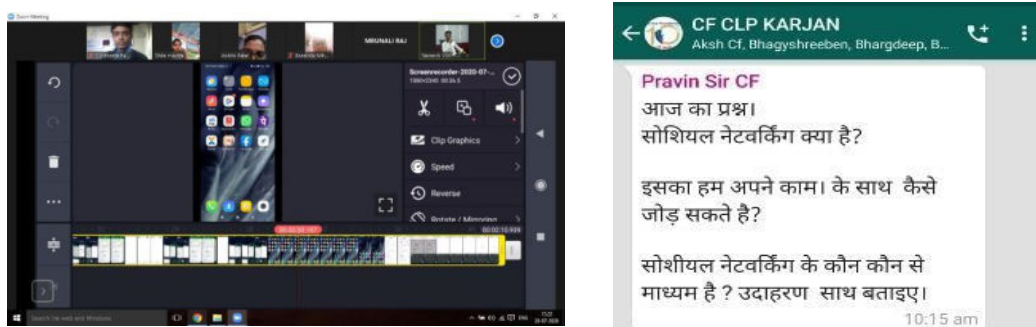

Upskilling of Cosmo Community Based Teachers

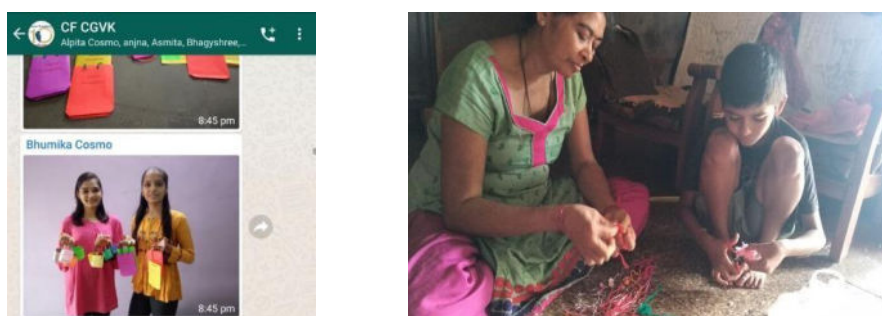
Cosmo Foundation utilized the optimum time of “Stay Home” period into the upskilling of community-based teachers on the digital platform across Karjan and Aurangabad.



An English Learning course for 85 teachers has been initiated by designing simple creative exercises covering conversation, phonics, grammar etc. and conducted zoom classes followed by Oral Mock Tests.

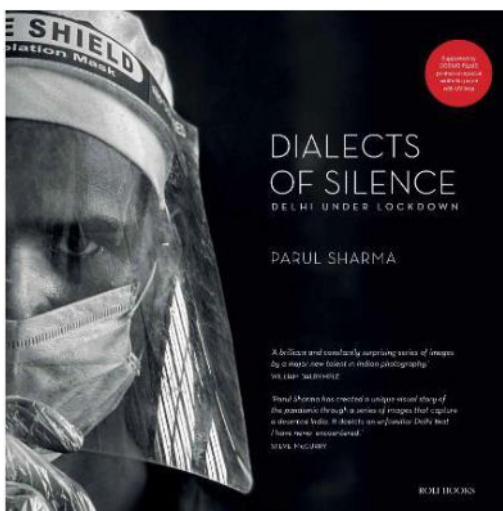

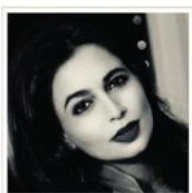

Food & Tricycle Distribution Camp

CF distributed 25 tricycles and served lunch to the resident of Tahirpur Leprosy Colony, Delhi with the support of ISKON. It was a grand initiative of CF to help poor and needy communities – where 5000 inmates were benefited.



Distribution of Cooked Meals

A mission Seva – 'Food for Life' was initiated to serve cooked meals to COVID patients and their families in 12 different containment zones across New Delhi with the support of ISKON. So far 7000 meals were served through contactless delivery.



Distribution of Grocery and Dry Ration Kits

As the second wave of COVID pandemic is turning life upside down and triggering another round for many, CF supported 29 girls of Cosmo Udayan Shalini Mentorship and Fellowship Program and 427 vulnerable families by distributing grocery kits whose family were affected due to COVID-19 across Jikthan, Puri and Turkabad villages of Gangapur block. Alongside, distributed 6400 kgs of dry ration kits to COVID warriors and their families residing in Haryana and Maharashtra.





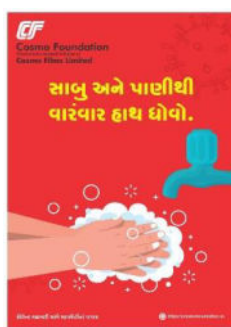
Vaccination Drive

Advocating the need to get vaccinated, CF hosted free of cost vaccination drive to inoculate non health front line warriors and individuals. **1000 individuals** including police personnel and their families, elderly inmates, ISKON devotees and community-based teachers were benefitted with close collaboration of Delhiites Foundation, Earth Saviour Foundation, South East District Police and JDAR path labs.



COVID Safety Kits to Rural Schools

Upon reopening of schools, CF distributed masks, soaps, napkins, automatic hand sanitizer machines, thermal guns, oximeters, and handwashing stands to 21 schools and 14 villages covering 3000+ students with the implementation support by Aruna Kishor Foundation. COVID awareness drive on digital platforms covered 5000 community members. Practical Awareness session on the importance and correct use and reuse of masks, methods of handwash, use of oximeters, thermal guns, natural temperature recording were undertaken.



COVID Awareness

A massive awareness campaign-cum-counselling of rural inhabitants on vaccination and following COVID protocols and behaviors practices were undertaken widely across all the villages in Karjan and Aurangabad.



A Step Towards Corona Free Village

CF initiated an Awareness Campaign to make the villages Corona free around its functional areas. CF identified Kothiya and Sadarana villages of Karjan Taluka. CF team relentlessly did a door-to-door survey in villages under the partnership of Gram Panchayats, Public Health Centers and Aruna Kishor Foundation and formed village-level committee to ensure 100% vaccination observing all COVID-19 protocols. A door-to-door survey with personal counseling of 1403 individuals was undertaken. So far 487 and 186 individuals took the first and second doses of the vaccine successfully.

One more Prestigious Feather on the Crown of Cosmo Foundation

On 15th July, 2021, CF has been conferred with the **Gold Award** in the category of **CSR Covid Relief Project** for the application being made under the title **“Response to Covid-19”**. These CSR Health Impact Awards are instituted by IHW Initiative (Integrated Health and Wellbeing Council). Amongst **140 entries**, **Cosmo Foundation** has been elected for this **Gold Award**.
