Educational initiatives remained central, with robust **summer batches** focusing on **Digital Literacy, English Fluency, and summer camps for children**. Special teacher training sessions enhanced educators' skills, while a dedicated **English coaching program** for over **300+ students from Industrial Training Institute** to enable them with **communication and employability skills**. Along with is marked National Technology Day by equipping rural youth with vital AI and digital competencies. Our inhouse team worked to **produce English learning videos for Hindi medium learners with the help of AI and grand summer camps with nearly 1000 young children**.

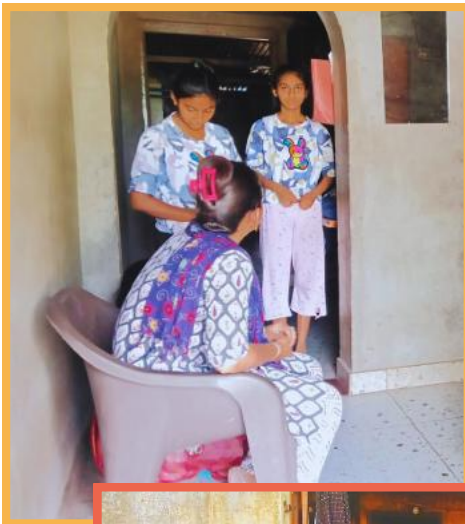
What I'm learning here will be a great asset for my future career. I'm truly grateful to Cosmo Foundation for offering such valuable and free English education to students like me."

English Fluency Development for Educators

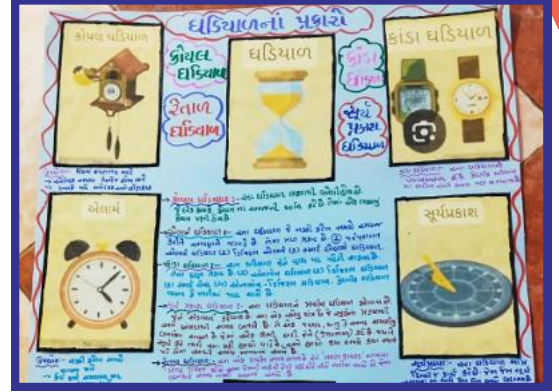
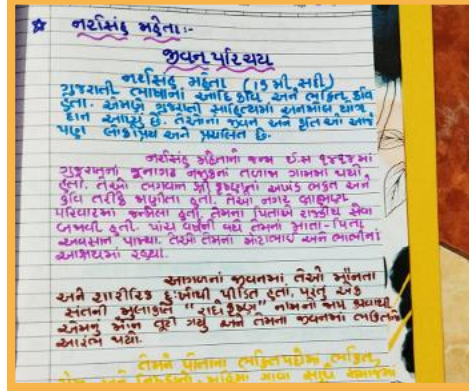
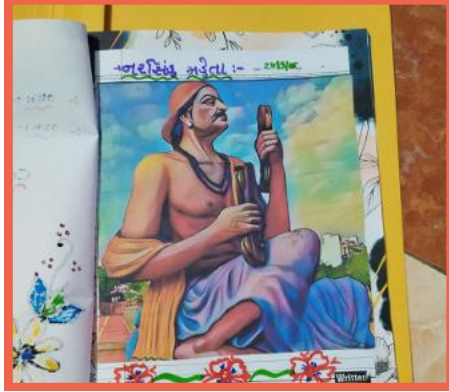
Igniting Minds

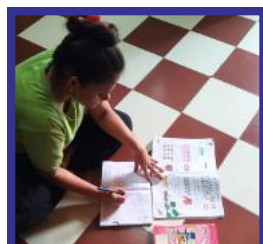
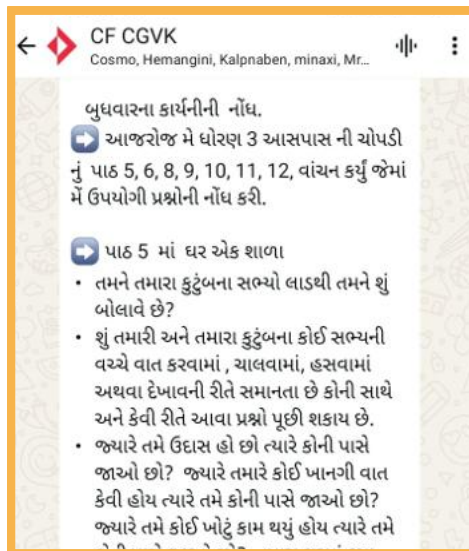
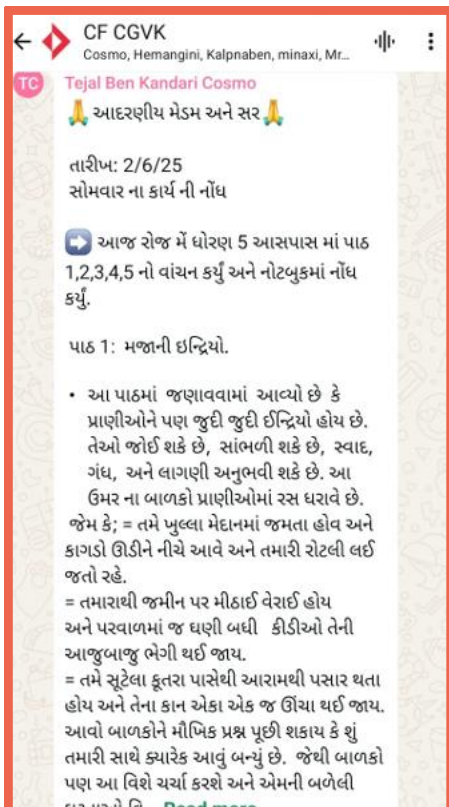


• Innovation in Action: Rural Learning Reimagined

In a significant step towards women's empowerment, Cosmo Foundation, **in collaboration with FICCI FLO Vadodadara organized a Breast Cancer Awareness program in the village- Bodka and Kanbha, reaching to 130 women.** Dr. Shruti Gohel from HCG Hospital led an insightful session focused on early detection, self-examination techniques, and understanding breast cancer risks—highlighting that 1 in 8 women globally are affected. She also explained through video self-examination technique and also did check-up of the women., The initiative enabled them to take charge of their well-being, reinforcing the belief that empowered women build healthier communities.
