Educational Assessment - Karjan

CF conducted the midterm assessments of all the students across the programs.

Basic English - Oral and written assessment of 1243 students of class 4th to 8th was completed. 66.37% students acquired complete recognition and writing skills of alphabets and numeracy, 85.04% learned loan words, sight words, 56.89% learned phonics sound, 77.12% word construction and simple greeting words, 36.07% can do simple sentence formation & oral communication.

Computer Operation - Practical and written assessment of 1941 students of class 3rd to 10th was completed. **Primary school students**- 75% learned mouse & keyboard operation, 95% acquired skills of digital art & basic calculation, 75% basic word. **High school students** - 65% of students acquired skills of table formatting, frequency & percentages formulation, typing and learned shot cut keys of MS word and Excel.

Foundational Literacy - Oral and written assessment of 1453 students of class 1st to 8th was completed. 39.43% students have an understanding of place value, numbers, basic sums of DMAS and reading skills. 44% learned small sentence formation, comprehension and picture reading, 39.02% of them have improved their Gujarati handwriting.

Educational Classes - Aurangabad

The regular classes of Foundational Literacy (Marathi, Urdu and Maths classes) and Computer Literacy Program are conducted.

English program is taking a momentum in Turkabad for 5th to 7th std and in Waluj for 10th class students. Alphabet with correct pronunciation, phonics, writing practice, oral communication and basic grammar were covered.

19th November 2022

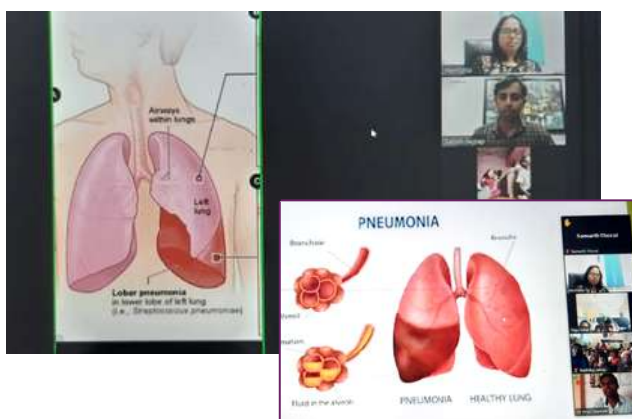
