Delhi

Covid Free Village Campaign

Cosmo Foundation launched Covid free village campaign in Sandarna and Kothiya village of Karjan.

Village committee has been formed with Gram Panchayat and local health center, door to door survey and counselling, poster campaign and puppet show, social distance norms at public places, painting competition in schools are some of the initiatives in collaboration with A.K.Foundation. 1407 people got vaccinated and 100% vaccination was done.

Education in New Normal

The reopening of schools certainly brought joy to students, but also posed a challenge of covid safety and bridging significant learning gaps. CF teachers had geared up with full enthusiasm and started Foundational literacy, Computer literacy and Basic English program in respective centers with due cleaning, hardware maintenance and updated classrooms with welcoming environment

Functional Digital Literacy

2966 students across Karjan and Aurangabad enrolled and imparted sessions on WPS Mobile Application, document formatting, advanced Google search techniques, poster design followed by curriculum of Computer literacy program

Basic English Communication

974 students from class 6th to 8th in Karjan were delivered lessons on self introduction, word construction with phonetics, word vocabulary, picture comprehension, expression and gesture, synonyms and antonyms

Foundational Literacy

1673 students across Karjan and Aurangabad were covered on storytelling, picture reading, money management, place values, DMAS, creative activities with live demonstration and health and hygiene awareness practices



Cosmo Digi Pathshala

Despite of reopening of schools, CF didn't stop WhatsApp learning platform. It also helps to 1st to 5th class students whose schools have yet not started. 1072 video e-contents with answer keys circulated to 1961 students in Karjan and 1057 in Aurangabad. Other than scheduled time table of digipathshala, CF highlighted subject of Olympics and Para Olympics games, organized virtual competitions and organized storytelling week for students. They actively participated with excellent performance.

Learning has no limits

Initially, my child studying in 5th standard, faced problem in reading fluently and my handwriting were also not good. But with daily participation in digi-pathshaala, she is now well aware with Gujarati and can make spelling of difficult words in English too. She started applying practicable math's in my daily life and adopted fine grip in DMAS and knowledge about COVID. She love story telling sessions of CF though puppets and animated videos. Cosmo Basic English Learning Capsule

It is been 7 month since the launch of Web Portal of English learning. It is taking its own momentum to learn English. It had created a deepest thrust in Cosmo team and twice a month a group study circle is conducted. Learners from diverse locations and various types of beneficiaries are engaged. Registration drive was conducted in 6 villages amongst schools, students and communities. So far 700 users are enrolled with total of 13000 video viewership.



Building power of correctness

I watched 5 videos of English grammar which includes - article a, an, the (advance level), simple present tense, past tense, past perfect and application of is/am/are. I learned correct sentence formation with all minute details and perfection. After watching these videos I realized my previous mistakes in English language which I corrected from English module. Cosmo Resource and e-Seva Centre

It is setup in two villages - Kothav and Handod. 485 people benefitted through various services like - light bill payments, gas cylinder booking, driving license renewal form, Aadhar card generation, online form for job application and army enrolment registrations. 44 online forms filled up for farmers to get benefit for the compensation of crop loss and registered on farmer's portal.



Capacity Building of Cosmo Teachers

Learning is the key source of development and study circle is the important tool to build capacity of teachers. CF organized 7 in-house study circles on virtual platform on the subjects like – New Education Policy and its implication on CF program, Value and importance of being a teacher, Linguistics and imparting teaching through video modules.



Cosmo Udayan Shalini Fellowship

30 girls from villages of Aurangabad enrolled and mentored by senior employees of Cosmo Films. Cosmo mentors meet was organized with USF conveners at Cosmo Films. A workshop organized on the communication and study skills for the Shalinis at Village Gajgao by Pravin Chauhan from Cosmo Foundation. Shalinis and their parents meet were organized at USF Aurangabad. Mr. More, Mr. Gupta and Mr. Mashalkar from Cosmo Films interacted with them about how education is important and how to pursue the path on acquiring higher education effectively.



Education Support

6 needy girls were identified from 8-12 standard in Karjan. As per their need, they are being provided text books, guides and notebooks and in house mentoring. They are also volunteering for making e-content for Digi Pathshala as well as art workshop for young students in villages of Karjan.

Pride of Cosmo

Ms. Dakshaben N Machhi – A young vibrant balmitra from Karjan awarded as the second rank amongst 450 participants in essay writing competition of the occasion of World Environment Day organized Gujarat Council of Science and Technology, Gandhinagar



17 students won in the National Online Elocution competition amongst a total of 33 participants and were organized by Ramkrishna Mission – Vivekananda Memorial, Vadodara. All the students were awarded with certificates.

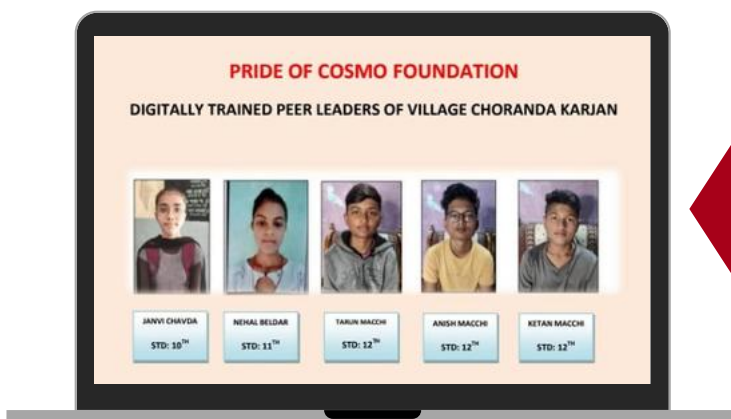

30 girls of 10th standard belonging from Waluj, Gajgoan and Turkabad villages of Aurangabad scored an outstanding result in the board examination in the range of 65% - 95% and few of them stood first in schools and villages. These girls were systematically trained in former years in Computer Literacy Program and during pandemic trained for Basic English Language , communication, goal setting, how to choose career

Health, Hygiene and Covid Awareness

CF believes in knowledge before practice, with such moto several awareness activities were undertaken with rural students, parents and community members through Digi-Pathshaala and community meetings. CF published and circulated series of posters and e-contents on COVID norms, importance of nutrition, awareness on vaccination , importance of using waste bins, segregation of dry, wet, plastic waste and how to make our village clean. Positive impact observed during home visits.
