Overview

June was a month of vibrant activity and strategic transitions for the Cosmo Foundation, marked by a strong focus on education and workforce readiness. We wrapped up its summer vacation batches with comprehensive evaluations and **concluded English course at ITIs** with post-test assessments and a celebratory farewell ceremony. The academic session began with **“Shala Praveshotsav”**- A school enrolment drive organized by **Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan** and **Cosmo Foundation** joined hands to welcome students by gifting drawing books to spark student creativity. Along with it International Yoga Day and Reading Day were marked with a pledge for fitness and strengthening knowledge with books.

Strengthening educators remained at the core of the month, with **comprehensive capacity-building programs** conducted for Computer Teachers, English Educators, and Balmitras, complemented by assessments to enhance technical proficiency, instructional quality, and classroom effectiveness.

Empowerment and livelihood initiatives took center stage through targeted digital and skill-building interventions. **Anganwadi workers** were introduced to the **Cosmo English Tutor platform** to enhance language learning as part of early childhood education, while **soft skills training and language orientation sessions** were conducted for the Electric Vehicle (EV) Technicians of ISIE India to strengthen their professional readiness. Additionally, **rural women** gained sustainable, **income-generating skills** through the Karigaar Clinic's **Business Wellness Program**, and foundation teams conducted on-site reviews with local farmers to analyse and strengthen their farm-based income sources..

Environmental stewardship and corporate synergy rounded out the month's impactful initiatives. **World Environment Day** was marked with plantation drive , seedball making and pledge for environmental sustainability across location, reinforcing a shared commitment to ecological sustainability alongside community growth.

Shaping the Future: The 2026–27 School Enrolment Drive

Under Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan's theme of "Celebrating Progress" for the 2026–27 academic year, Cosmo Foundation joined the **three-day School Enrollment Festival across 35 partner schools**. To welcome **800+ newly enrolled children** in Anganwadi, Balvatika, and Grade 1, the Foundation distributed drawing books and color kits, sparking early creativity. Throughout the celebration, local schools, School Management Committees (SMCs), and education boards acknowledged and **honored Cosmo Foundation** for its institutional commitment to education. This milestone underscores the powerful synergy between government authorities, Gram Panchayats, and the Foundation in advancing child-centered community learning.

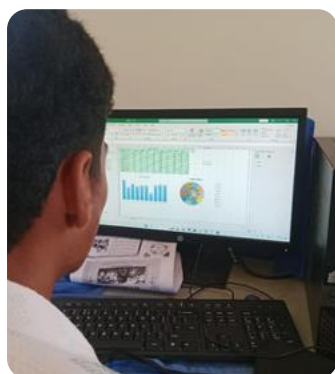
Empowering Rural Youth Through Digital and Language Skills This Summer

This summer, while classrooms fell silent for vacation, learning never paused for the youth of 14 villages across Gujarat and Maharashtra. Cosmo Foundation, in partnership with local schools and ITIs, conducted intensive **45-day courses** in **Digital Skill Building** and **Basic & Fluent English Course**, transforming summer break into a season of growth. **228 students** mastered **Computer Basics**, gaining hands-on fluency in essential hardware and software operations, while **275 students advanced** further, developing proficiency in MS Office, ChatGPT, Gemini, Canva, NotebookLM, social media platforms, and e-commerce fundamentals — tools that are rapidly redefining tomorrow's workplace. Parallely, language emerged as a bridge to opportunity. **336 students**, including **ITI learners, shalinis and youth**, achieved **Communication fluency** in English, while **269 students** built strong **foundational communication skills** through the interactive **Cosmo English Tutor platform**. By weaving together digital literacy and language proficiency, this initiative gave rural youth more than just new skills — it gave them the confidence to step boldly into a technology-driven future.

Bridging the Tech-Language Divide in Karjan & Gotri Industrial Technical Institutes

From **November 2025 to June 2026**, Cosmo Foundation conducted **196 hours** of intensive **English Communication Classes** for **266 youth** at **Karjan and Gotri ITIs** (Industrial Training Institute), bridging a critical gap in professional readiness. Recognizing that technical industry terminology was a major hurdle for students, the curriculum specifically focused on trade-specific vocabulary and practical workplace conversations alongside foundational reading, writing, speaking, and listening exercises. Additionally, the program provided targeted **coaching aligned with the GSEB** (Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board) pattern for **94 students** appearing for the **Class 12 English examination, a milestone that grants ITI graduates equivalency to pursue higher education and university degrees**. This dual-focused approach built the students' confidence, enabling them to confidently navigate modern industrial environments and express themselves more fluently. The initiative culminated in June with a heartfelt farewell ceremony, where graduates received essential career guidance on future employability pathways, marking a significant step forward in their academic and professional journeys.

Tech Proficiency: Training of Computer Teachers

To ensure the delivery of high-quality digital education, Cosmo Foundation organized an intensive **10-day, 40-hour capacity-building training program for computer teachers at Karjan**. The comprehensive curriculum blended organizational orientation and level-wise technical training with practical demonstration designed for accuracy in classroom delivery and teaching methodologies. A rigorous **post-training skills assessment** through written test, practical test and teaching demo session highlighted the program's success, revealing the educators demonstrated significant improvement in technical proficiency, and readiness to lead modern digital classrooms.

Building Foundations: Training of Balmitras

With an aim to expand creativity, curiosity and learning outcomes among children at Cosmo Gyan Vihar Kendra, Cosmo Foundation organized a comprehensive three-day, 18-hour capacity-building training program for 24 Balmitras at Karjan. The intensive curriculum aligned with contemporary standards by covering organizational objectives, the National Education Policy (NEP), foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN) principles, and level-wise curriculum planning. Through interactive workshops and demonstration-based learning, participants mastered the effective use of Teaching-Learning Materials (TLMs) and explored innovative methodologies for early childhood care, language, and mathematics education. The program concluded with an evaluation test to assess subject mastery of the Balmitras' capacity to deliver high-quality, impactful learning experiences for children in rural communities.

Training and Assessment on English Language Proficiency

To maximize teaching impact, Cosmo Foundation organized a **Study Circle** for its **Cosmo teachers** during the summer vacation, focusing on topics such as loan words, word construction, phonics, vowels, and consonants. The initiative featured a rigorous 100-mark **assessment** designed to evaluate **25 participating teachers** on foundational program knowledge, core subject matter, and classroom methodologies. The results were highly encouraging. The educators demonstrated the deep linguistic understanding and instructional confidence required to lead high-impact English learning, ensuring the delivery of top-tier language interventions across all project locations.

In observance of World Environment Day, **employees of Cosmo First and Cosmo Foundation** across Cosmo First's operational locations translated ecological consciousness into tangible action through a series of purposeful, localized initiatives. In **Maharashtra**, **30 employees** undertook a tree plantation drive, planted **150 saplings** at Plantation Site 2, Biodiversity Hub, Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, in collaboration with the **Prayas Youth Foundation**. At the Cosmo First Karjan Plant of **Gujarat**, employees enriched the plant premises with newly **planted trees**, while over **60 employees pledged** their individual commitment to environmental responsibility. In **Delhi**, **30 employees** from Cosmo First convened for an engaging **seed ball-making workshop**, conceived to restore biodiversity and safeguard natural resources for future generations. 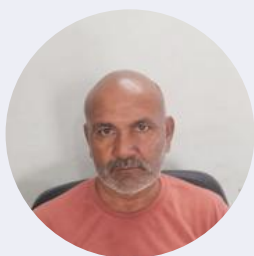

Cultivating Resilience: Karjan's Agroforestry Triumph

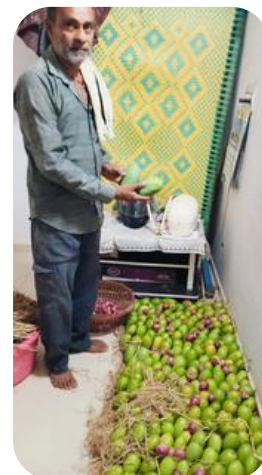
The **Agroforestry Project** in Karjan is delivering on its promise of sustainable prosperity. This season, 66 forward-thinking farmers celebrated a bountiful mango harvest, unlocking up to **₹45,000 in additional income** per family. More than just a financial boost, these orchards serve as a crucial safety net. As unpredictable weather patterns disrupted traditional seasonal crops, this diversifying model provided a vital shield, safeguarding rural livelihoods when they needed it most. By seamlessly blending ecological conservation with economic security, the initiative proves that green strategies build resilient, thriving agricultural communities for the long haul.



Progress of farm based livelihood opportunities

Through Cosmo Foundation's Tree Plantation Drive, I received 227 mango saplings, training, and organic inputs to begin agroforestry on my land. This year, unpredictable rainfall damaged our seasonal crops, but the mango plantation became our safety net. Following the Foundation's continuous training sessions, we nurtured the trees with care since the very first season. In this third year, our saplings bore fruit, generated an additional income of ₹45,000 — giving my family a reliable second source of livelihood and a sense of independence even in an uncertain season.
