Overview

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The 10th Cosmo Computer Award: Empowering Rural Excellence in Digital Literacy

The 10th Cosmo Computer Award is a prestigious initiative aimed at recognizing and rewarding excellence in digital literacy among students in rural areas. This year, the award honored 1000 students across 27 schools for their achievements in the Digital Literacy Program. The award is inspired by the visionary thoughts of the Chairman of Cosmo First Ltd. and is organized in partnership with Shreeji Krupa Sarvajanik Vidyalaya.

Strengthening Community Roots: Employee Engagement at New Jithardi

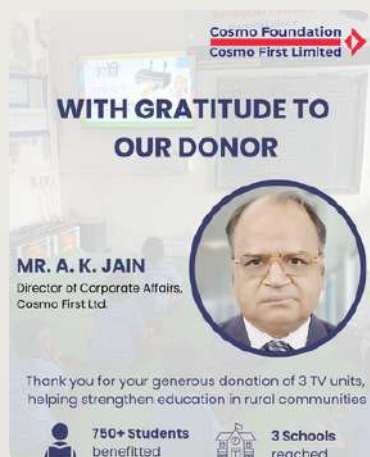
