The year passed was full of diverse activities that convey as to how it reached to the unreached. The organization spearheaded educational, environmental and philanthropic programs across Gujarat, Maharashtra and New Delhi.

We set up four new computer labs in villages of Aurangabad and upgraded 12 computer Labs in villages of Vadodara. Thus, computer literacy program was running with 21 computer labs. Cosmo Gyan Vihar Kendra has been of a great value to strengthen basic literacy, enhance participation of students and parents in education. Health and hygiene, communication and interpersonal skills, study skills have added value in overall development of the children. English Literacy with primary school students in Karjan and digitizing the content considering the challenges of rural students and teachers for this international language was a herculean task.

We can see the fruits of our program where Cosmo community-based teachers and students started teaching learning process on digital platform much early before Covid-19 pandemic was rising and appearing on the territorial global horizon.

Hygiene was the areas of core concern for Cosmo Foundation. The organization constructed sanitation blocks with hand wash facility for boys and girls across four schools in Aurangabad. Software activities were simultaneously carried out for maintenance of toilet blocks and behavior change.

Community members primarily parents are the crucial link to enhance education and development of children. We organized series of awareness programs on nutrition, oral hygiene, menstrual and reproductive health, safe- unsafe touch.

Our consistent efforts to lighting up lives of community with knowledge, skills, behavior change, exposure and humane values is gradually bringing transformational changes. The pandemic has changed the landscape of development sector. We as a team with great adaptability and determination are consistently marching to realize our mission.

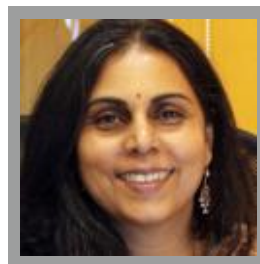

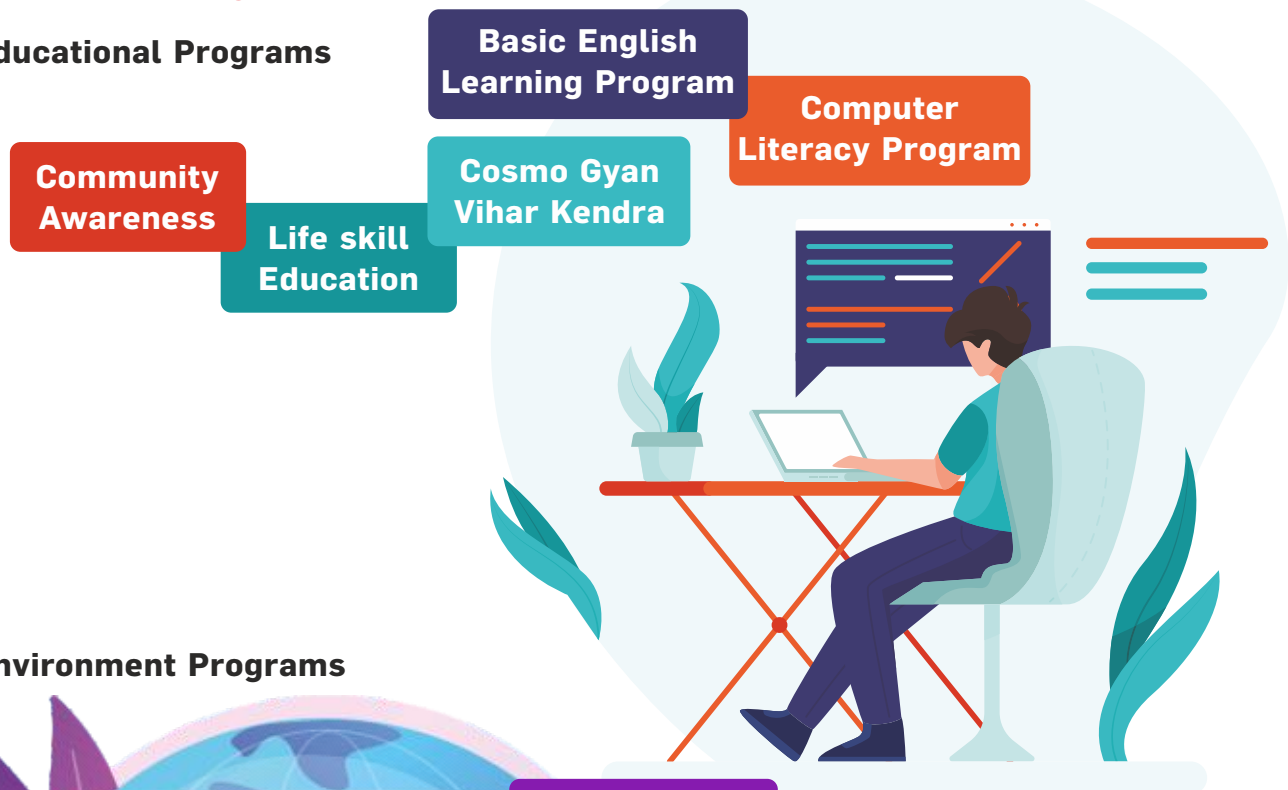
1. To impart Basic Reading, Writing, Arithmetic skills among young children to build foundation to strengthen their future learning in mainstream education.

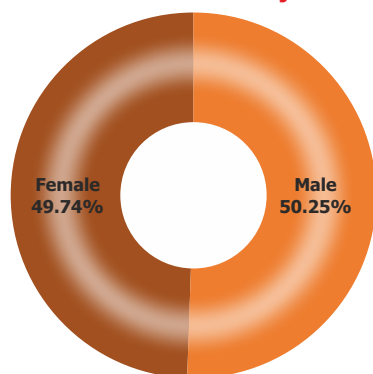

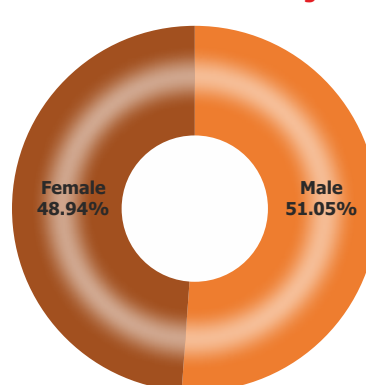

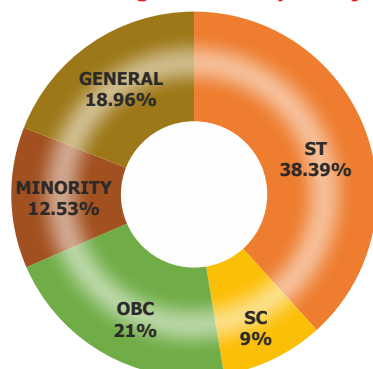
Gender Ratio - Karjan



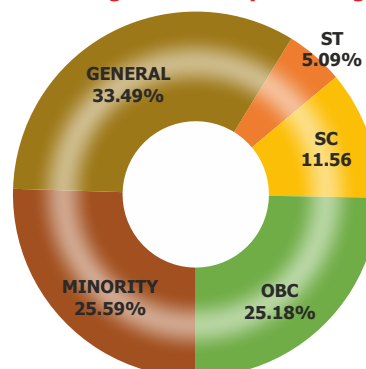
Gender Ratio - Aurangabad

Educational Programs



Vidhya: An Initiative Towards Holistic Education

In India with introduction of Right to Education Act, the basic enrollment ratio in primary schools have immensely increased. It has improved in scaling the number in education, but the quality of education remains the question of concern for all. This is a greater concern for the rural and tribal pockets in particular.

Cosmo Foundation recognizes that education gives a new lease of life to empower individuals to make informed choices and opens new possibilities and opportunities for themselves.

Cosmo has got a very comprehensive education program that focuses on the overall development of children and on the socio-economic environment under which they live and exist. The values of our organization are based on the belief that each child deserves an equal opportunity

for learning. The organization aims to strengthen fundamentals of literacy which builds concepts of language, arithmetic, awareness of self and surroundings. Pedagogy and strategies are innovative and participatory, range of teaching learning material developed, involves parents into education processes and implant positive attitude towards education.

Basic English Learning Program

Prospect to advance potential of rural students

Basic English Learning Program is diligently and swiftly moving ahead to ignite the mindset of rural marginalized community to enhance their skill in English communication.



Language plays a most pivotal role in communication. English, being the global accepted language, has spread its wings in every nook and corner in everyone's life. In the present era of Information Age, English is undoubtedly the most important tool of communication and conversation. Students in India are exposed to their local regional language studies right from their primary level, barring CBSC and public schools. English is taught only as a third language in Gujarat and Maharashtra.

In this scenario after identifying the needs and requirements from local teachers, parents and considering the thirst from every quarter, Cosmo Foundation has annexed Basic English Learning Program with its flagship Computer Literacy Program in the year 2010. CF fundamentally believed in "Catch Them Young". To begin with, it started in ten Primary Schools of eight villages of Karjan Block and covered 967 students. In this year, as per the demand of the villagers for adapting to educate their children in English learning, CF initiated a special evening class for two hours from 5 to 7 p.m. in Vemar and Methi villages of Karjan block. Now over a period of our untiring journey, we have developed our own curriculum and unique teaching methods and adopted a path to teach easy English through local language – Gujarati.

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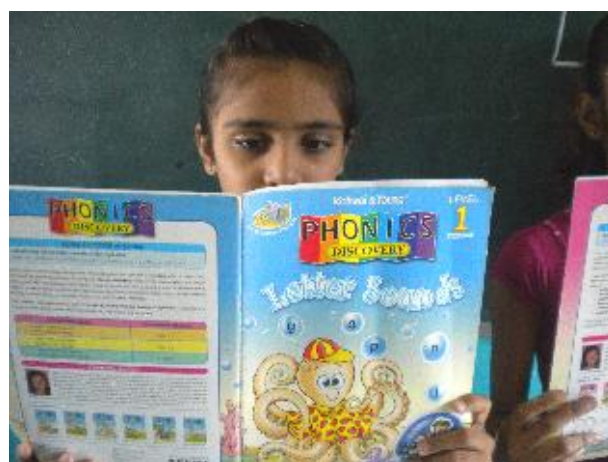
Significant Features of English Program

- Communicative Approach is the main focal area.
- Focus is primarily on LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing).
- Children are classified as per their ability to understand the topics and accordingly grade wise curriculum is designed.
- Pre-Test of Chosen Topics-Teaching Learning Session-Post Test
- To strengthen the skill of formation of three/four letter words with spelling and pronunciation with writing skill, phonics approach is adopted.
- Indicator based Assessment.

Emphasis of Teaching Methodology

Our core emphasis was on - phonics and phonetic sounds, appropriate pronunciation, construction of words, expression through action words, basic communicative English, Greetings through live interactive sessions.

We make wide use of teaching learning materials on story books, videos, day to day conversation practice, calendar drill, teaching learning session on vertical, slanting, slant lines and curves on four-line books for easy learning and drawing fair outline of first and second alphabets, four-line laminated sheets for lines and curves, pictorial charts i.e. posters and flash cards for building confidence for public speaking by various practical and theoretical exercises. A positive outcome was observed among students by learning etiquettes, discipline and manner.



Digitalization of English Course



Cosmo Foundation, recognized the challenges of rural students and community pertaining to English language. It was a herculean task to get right coach and mentor to teach English in their mother tongue with systematic and scientific approach. Therefore, digital pre-recorded sessions on learning English are prepared to deliver the correct and scientific knowledge of each content amongst the students. It consists of four different modules covering in detail 90 topics on these pre-recorded videos. It is based on syllabus being taught during the entire period of ten years under this Basic English Learning

program. It will cater the needs of primary school students, high school students, university students, home makers, job seekers who aspire to learn and wish to build the skill of English communication.

Vocabulary Kit – ‘Simple English Conversation Practice’



We groom students for day-to-day etiquettes and manners to harness their potentialities, unfold their outlook, personality development and achieve the success in the field of academia. With a view to strengthening the skill of communicative English, CF published a book entitled “English Conversation Practice. It consists daily English conversation sentences in English and Gujarati language in a question answer format. This book was written and conceived by our Sr. English faculty, Mr. Pravin Chauhan. The sole purpose of this book was to strengthen student’s skill in day-to-day situational conversation in daily routine with correct pronunciation and enhance the skill of fluency in English. A forward was written by our Managing Trustee Ms. Yamini Jaipuria. This book was launched by Mr. Kiran Zhaveri, District Development Officer, Baroda.

A book entitled, ‘English Conversation Practice’ will strengthen the communication skills and I am confident that beneficiaries from any quarters or any walks of life will fulfil their needs and dreams to learn correct and fluent English Communication from this book.

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Results of English Assessment

Twice a year English assessment is undertaken. This year out of 909 students, 497 students were upgraded to higher level with the score of 70 percentages and above. The overall result mapped was 55% by covering the entire English syllabus.

Qualitative Outcome

- Majority of the students can give their self-introduction and others introduction.
- Majority of the students learned word construction e.g. family members, body parts, name of vegetables and fruits, days and months.
- With the help of phonics, students can read two/three/four letters words with correct pronunciation.
- Understand instructions in English and make use of its application in daily routine.
- Majority of the students gained clear understanding in 'Simple Present Tense', construct sentence and speak based on application of this tense.
- Majority of the students acquired good handwriting skill in four lines books.
- Students have adopted certain conversation sentences in their daily routines.

I am very much grateful to Cosmo Foundation for its unique and easy way of teaching English with a basic fundamental learning. Use of four-line books has improved students handwriting. Students are now able to read and write English sentence. I see their level of self-assurance in public speaking also. They are now introducing themselves in English with manners and etiquettes and it has added value to our school environment.

On The Path Of Leading-edge Technology Computer Literacy Program

Today we are living in digital era. It is an age where basic digital literacy is a prerequisite to perform any day-to-day task. Basic computer skill is an inevitable need for any human beings. Thus, Cosmo Foundation has initiated Basic Computer Literacy Program where children and youth are trained under basic operational skills. Students aspiring to pursue higher study are trained with higher level of topics.

In year 2019-20, we set up computer program in three new Govt schools in Karjan and four Govt schools in Aurangabad. 5000 students from class one to class nine covered under this program.

Significant features:

Four new computer Labs set up in Govt schools of Gangapur block at Aurangabad

and nine computer labs upgraded in Karjan.

Basic computer, internet, social media and e-commerce course was done with students enrolled in Industrial Technical Institute, Karjan.

With support of Cosmo Foundation 15 students from Puri completed MSCIT course with first class from village: Puri, Aurangabad.

25 high school students of village Methi, Aurangabad were imparted training on Adobe Photoshop designing software by university intern.

Young students in primary schools are very enthusiastic to operate computers. It has enhanced school enrollment and reduced absenteeism in schools.

Our heartfelt gratitude to Cosmo Films for the donation of 185 desktops and electrification of 13 computer labs in current year.

Cosmo Foundation is doing great work in Karjan block in the field of education. Due to its untiring dedication, the students of our institute got benefited and we are grateful to Cosmo Foundation.

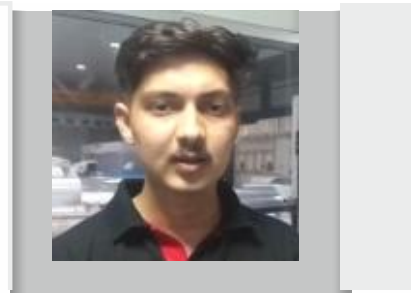
Resource Investment on Summer Holidays

During the summer holidays, a training program was conducted to train rural youth and women. Various training includes Computer, Internet, e-Commerce, Online form filling, Digital Transactions. This training course was undertaken at 8 schools around Karjan Block. 158 participants took the benefit of this training. 77 participants completed the whole course successfully. Similarly, at Aurangabad, Basic Computer Course was organized in five Schools and 311 students were benefitted.

Building Pillars Of Education

Cosmo Gyan Vihar Kendra is working on the basic skills of reading, writing, arithmetic and life skills to improve the fundamental education in primary schools. The basic purpose of the program is not only to improve the quality of fundamental education but also improving the quality of overall education and broadening the horizon of the thought process. The unique feature of this program is training the local women as Balmitra who can get employment as a trainer for this program. The program is functional in 20 Villages, 1730 students benefit and implemented with 35 Balmitras in Karjan. Similarly, in Aurangabad, 6 Villages, 688 students and with 16 Balmitras.

Significant features:

Program was expanded to 2 Villages in Karjan and 4 in villages at Gangapur.

Early Child Care Education (ECCE) component was introduced and 237 students of preprimary section were covered at Karjan. Enhanced attendance of students in school and academic performance. 54 students from class 9th were equipped with basic literacy skills by

specifically organized remedial classes in two villages.

On the basis of competencies and coordinating skills, 5 Balmitra were made the Cluster Heads of CGVK and given the sole responsibilities of inputs and monitoring of the Balmitras of their five villages. It has promoted leadership and sense of ownership.

"Remedial classes could bring big difference among the students of class 9th, who could not even identify basic alphabets, started to read, write and count. Out of 54, 28 students acquired reading, writing and numeric skills in native language".

Celebrating International Literacy Day:

As a part of International Literacy Day, 493 children and 552 parents from 12 villages participated in signature campaign. They signed in English, Hindi and Gujarati language. The purpose behind was to measure the language, knowledge, skill to write neatly and skill to sign one's own signature. For serving this purpose Balmitra went door to door to collect the signature samples from children and parents. The results of the campaign were as follows:

Learning in Summer with Fun

Similarly, 234 students attended summer camps from villages of Aurangabad. It covered indoor - outdoor games, science experiments, village rally on child's rights and craft, visit to village institutions like bank, panchayats, dairy etc., tiffin parties, puppet shows, yoga and news reading, mathematical activities on measurements, movie screening, session

on constitutional structure from village to country. On the last day parents and villagers were invited to see the camps and it got an overwhelming response. In Karjan children prepared refreshments too and it has inculcated values of sharing and learning. Village leaders and Balmitras provided voluntary refreshments and exemplary ownership was seen in Karjan. In two villages of Karjan theme-based camps on nutrition, environment, Swachhta, self-awareness was organized with the help of Nutan Balshikshan Sanstha.

Life Skill Education

Towards Wholistic Development

Life skills-based education is a form of education that focuses on cultivating personal life skills such as self-reflection, critical thinking, problem solving and interpersonal skills.



COSMO Foundation has seen education in larger context. The reach of education is not only limited with the numerical and alphabetical literacy for children, but the main aim was to encourage the children to have skills which can help students deal with their life today and tomorrow in a true meaningful way. The life skill education imparted under this initiative inspires

children to develop wings of fire to fly in the infinitive space of one's own growth and development. This program was launched in Karjan in the year 2015.

The key objective of conceiving this concept of Life Skill Education is pre-readiness for formal education.

CF conceived and developed followings modules

Module: 1 Health and Hygiene

The health and hygiene module is developed keeping in mind the personal wellness of community members. They were exposed to have maintenance of cleanliness and good hygiene practice and variety of interesting activity-based topics were taught using different methods.

Under the oral health awareness program, 500 children from Mangrol and Kurali Primary school and Anganwadi were brought on one platform for thorough dental check up by an expert medical team

representing Department of Public Dentistry, Sumandeep Vidhyapith, Pipaliya. 970 children from 10 schools were checked up earlier. They were brought again for thorough routine dental checkup and they were suggested with duly prescribed measures to follow with medication.

Apart from this program focused on importance of personal hygiene and behavior change. As a result of implementation of this module followed by awareness program by team, we observed the following impacts

1. 92% of the children started cutting their nails by themselves regularly.
2. Children have made it a practice to wash their hands themselves while returning back from playing
3. Washing hands before and after Mid-Day Meal at school and using toilets.
4. Gargling after having meals
5. 46% children brush their teeth twice a day and also learned to brush teeth in correct way.
6. Children started making correct choices for eating food.
7. 54% children started using handkerchief during cough and cold and also started wearing slippers.
8. Children started keeping their houses and surrounding clean and neat.

Module: 2 Creativity

The purpose behind this module is to develop the environment which can nurture creativity among the children's mindset and promote out of box thinking. .

Activities

- Imagination activities of developing and narrating stories
- Variety of designing Rangoli, Toran, Finger print painting and decorating houses, preparing innovative meals, art and craft.

Results

- Children learnt to develop jokes which makes them laugh the most.
- Imagining variety of ending to the stories so that children develop better imagination.
- Children tried to develop new riddles.
- Children started developing their original way of thinking and learnt to use innovative material to make rangoli and toran.

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Module: 3 Study Skills

Developing Physical and mental concentration, Consciousness for remembrance required for studying skills. Students develop interpretative skills regarding subject matter.

Activities

- Different activities related to Time Management
- Interpretation of subject matter
- Mental Concentration and Memory

Results of the module implementation

- Children started probing and questioning from stories
- Children started concluded moral, information, guess and references from the stories
- Children started developing curiosity
- Increased observation and memory.
- Children became more dutiful.
- Started working with accuracy
- They learnt comprehension, listening techniques, observations, chronology and analytical skills.





Module:4 Personal and Social Relations and Behavior

The purpose of the module is to develop mutual family weaving, equality, understanding, importance of cooperation, positive behavior and understanding value inculcation.

Result for implementation of module:

- Understanding the difference between the 'Do's and 'Don'ts' at home
- Developed good habits and respecting others
- Understanding the situation at home, they stopped becoming stubborn.
- Children started following gender equality at home in all household work and also in society
- Started taking care of younger siblings

Module:5 Logical and Analytical Thought Process

The purpose of the module was to make children more rational and meticulous in observing smallest things

- Students try to listen to the minutest sound, different variety of sound, and accuracy in listening
- Students learn to develop vision for variety of colours
- Students develop accuracy in vision

Results for implementation of module

- Children could recognise sound with accuracy
- Children could experience childhood
- Children could develop balance in vision in accuracy towards their sight and hearing, children could recognise the sounds from their surroundings.

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"I was suffering from the skin infection due to the lack of the cleanliness. After joining Life Skill course of Cosmo Foundation, I started maintaining cleanliness and now my skin infection is reduced. I started taking care of health and hygiene. I actively participated in the school cleaning activity also reduced my expenses and started helping my mother in work. Capacity Building Of Community-based Teachers : Building Knowledge Resource At Grassroot

Cosmo Foundation has trained and engaged local women and youth as Bamiltras to impart basic literacy, computer teachers and English trainee teachers. This group is the pillar of the program to transform one's own life and rural community. Cosmo Foundation systematically invests to build their vision, skills and expand their exposures.

Training of Balmitras:

- Three Balmitras participated in a training organized by Nai Talim Sangh on pre primary education.
- Through the efforts of Young Indians, CII, Soft Skill trainings of Cosmo teachers were organized which enhanced their teaching and communication skills with students.
- Fourteen Balmitras visited Science Fair organized by Vadodara Municipal Corporation and learnt new experiments and techniques.



- Balmitra were trained in different life skill education modules (Study skills, Interpersonal relationship, Analytical thinking)
- More advance mathematical elements and Gujarati grammar elements were taught.
- They were also trained to use Chess and Puppets for teaching and oriented to Early Child Care Education Course.

Training of English Trainee Teachers



During this year, 20 teaching sessions were conducted amongst English trainee teachers, Balmitras and computer teachers of Karjan to strengthen and enhance their skills for teaching. To combine English in their daily teaching sessions and gradually they will be engaged as a English trainee teacher. Training was conducted on classroom conversation, functional grammar, phonics etc. to build English proficiency skills. Alongside five rounds of assessment were done to measure their skills, learning and to analysis and gauge their in-depth

knowledge and self-study for onward transmission to deliver amongst students.

Training of Computer Teachers

In house training of computer teachers were conducted at Karjan and Aurangabad to update skills on basic operations and subject delivery. Apart from this training were imparted on database, social media, effective email writing, work etiquettes. Exposure visit of computer teachers of Aurangabad was arranged to Computer Engineering Department, Baba Saheb Ambedkar Marathawada University.



Hygiene And Environmental Programs Green And Clean Bharat...



Under Swacchh Bharat mission, all villages, Gram Panchayats, Districts, States and Union Territories in India declared themselves "Open-Defecation Free" (ODF) by 2 October 2019, by constructing over 100 million toilets in rural India. This includes factors like access to safe toilets and also whether there is visible cleanliness around households and public places.

To contribute in the same direction COSMO Foundations taken up efforts for cleanliness campaigns in schools and in communities, building toilets and also training people to use toilets in correct way.

Prayas -Developing Hygienic Habits for Better Tomorrow

- The School Cleanliness monitoring committees are developed to constantly guide and monitor the personal and environment cleanliness in school and among the students. Personal hygiene included – Good habits and self-hygiene awareness. The environmental cleanliness was broadened amongst students for maintaining cleanliness and hygiene in their surrounding which includes, their classes, schools, houses, toilets, and all the cleanliness tools.



- A booklet was developed and launched on Appropriate Use and Maintenance of Toilet Block on "World Toilet Day".
- Workshops were planned in 12 schools of Karjan block with the help of teachers, Balmitras guided students to make appropriate use of handkerchief, wearing footwears and habit of keeping the footwears in line.
- A unique initiative was taken up as part of 150 years of celebration of Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October. CF pledged and adopted Kanbha and Bodka villages to make them "Plastic Free Village".



Cosmo Foundation

Cosmo Foundation under aegis of schools, Gram Panchayat organised the rally with 306 participants. The participant groups collected 80 Kgs. of plastics and the same was sent to Karjan Municipality for recycling.

No to Single Use Plastic Campaign



- As a part of its initiative, **CF started 9 Pad banks in Karjan block** and distributed 150 packets of pads in eight villages. Currently 713 girls are using the pads. Each centre has two students and a teacher. CF volunteers and regularly monitors through Balmitra

and Teachers and ensure that they guide and train the girls to use it rightfully and follow the practice of disposal of these sanitary napkins.

- E-Waste Disposal :** From the date of its running the Computer Literacy Program, Cosmo Foundation is sensitive towards ecology and environment. It has been regularly undertaking the exercise of e-waste management of its scrapped computer materials by engaging external agency for its proper disposal and recycling and reuse of these spares.



Felicitation of 50 Safai Sevaks of Karjan



Waste Bin Installation: 150 wastebins were installed in Karjan and 75 waste bins were installed in Gangapur.



Construction of School Toilets: In 4 Govt. Schools of Gangapur block of Aurangabad District, 7 toilet blocks for boys and 25 toilet blocks for girls were constructed. With a view to ensuring the continual availability of water, CF has constructed 6 water tanks in Gangapur.



Tree Plantation: 774 tree saplings were planted in Karjan and 125 were planted in Gangapur. To have its safe protection, 50 tree guards were given in Karjan and 130 in Gangapur.

- With the help of children participating in Cleanliness Committee, school children have started washing their hands, food dishes, orderly sitting in the line and hardly spill any foods from the plates.
- Teacher in Kanbha village provided Rs. 800/- to children participating in Cleanliness Committee to clean toilets, and learnt that it is imperative to have continual cleaning of toilets on daily basis.
- Due to encouragement by teachers and others, children are now not feeling ashamed to clean toilets.
- Earlier there were no arrangements for disposal of sanitary napkins. Girls were hesitant in using pads. Upon regular meeting to make use of pads, girls started using the pads. Regular monitoring and guiding them, girls, of late, have willingly followed the practice of proper disposal of sanitary napkins.
- As part of rally 80 Kg plastic was sent to Karjan Municipality for recycling.
- Due to awareness on cleanliness amongst community members, the demand of garbage bins has increased. Panchayats too have also arranged for deploying more cleaning workers for disposal of garbage.
- These days, the school premises are seen clean due to intervention of Cosmo Foundation, as it installed garbage bins within the premises of respective schools. Children too have formed the habit of using the garbage bins and throw the refuse in waste bins only.

Parents Engagement & Community Awareness

Transforming Lives...

Every day, we read in newspapers and heard in news channel about the toxic fumes that are engulfing the cities. There are many affordable and feasible ways of disposing waste to restore the eco system and keep the environment neat and clean. With a view to creating a better and beautiful place to live, it is essential and imperative on the part of people to shoulder equal responsibility and participate in all the development issues related to people welfare.

Purpose:

Every organization situated in any geographical areas, there it becomes the social and moral responsibility of such organization to spread awareness of uplifting the social standard of community members. In this context, Cosmo Foundation has been on the forefront to spread education, cleanliness and nutrition at community level to improve their standard of living.

During the year 2019-20, Cosmo foundation had organized primarily the following community awareness programs.



Dental Care Awareness Program: 970 children from 10 schools who were checked earlier were again gone through a routine dental check-up and suggested with prescribed measures to follow the practice of dental care.



An Awareness program by Young India on "Good Touch and Bad Touch": Young India Forum with Cosmo Foundation organized a training program on "Good and Bad Touch", where 55 employees, Balmitras and Anganwadi workers from Karjan were trained in the same field. The program also gave an insight and awareness regarding POSCO Act. Also gave training to train children for self-defence technique.

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Awareness regarding Nutritional Food: 4 schools of Karjan block and 120 girls students studying in 8 to 12 students participated in a nutrition awareness program. As part of the program the students were made aware about the nutritional elements and local food habits and nutritional availability in the food. Importance of having nutritional food and follow the practice of consuming good food habits. The program also explained about different food groups and importance of including different food groups in daily meals.



International Yoga Day – In the era of modern technology, maintaining physical and mental fitness is the prime priority for every individual. On the eve of International Yoga Day, 40 employees of Cosmo Foundation were deputed to undergo the training for yoga and meditation. Volunteers of Bramha Kumarist trained these participants.



Women's day was celebrated by Cosmo Foundation by booking a special movie show "Diya the Wonder Girl" where 95 young girls and 67 women from 6 villages enjoyed this movie.



Namami Narmade Program was organized in Karjan Municipality and as part of its activities, CF had undertaken the drives of tree plantation, wall painting and cleanliness.



Vali Sabha- Sandhya Sabha- A unique initiative by Cosmo Foundation was initiated to connect with the parents through students beneficiaries, where parents, employees of foundation, teachers, Balmitra and village level leaders and workers assembled on one platform at Navi Nagri to interact about the various programs run by CF. It is also a platform where foundation talks to parents and local people regarding importance of education, cleanliness, nutrition, training and skill development. These are communicated through videos, audios, photo presentations, and using various communication methods.

During year 2019-20, CF organized 43 evening meeting with parents in 19 villages where 880 parents participated. During the course of this meeting, 24 past students and 3 past volunteers of foundation were felicitated from the local villages for pursuing their higher education and explored the opportunity for their employments. Parents appreciated the efforts of foundation.

- The students of Muslim community who used to miss the Madressa class in the morning the parents requested for evening CGVK classes for their children.
- Parents committed to send their children regularly for education and looking after their children carefully.
- Parents wanted their children to participate in all activities.
- Parents also requested to generate the opportunity to offer them the suitable job.
- Irregular students became regular.
- First time the evening get-together and the experience sharing of past students inspired the new students. This initiative brought and established a unique identity of CF in the eyes of rural community.

Philanthropic Initiatives

1. Celebration of Ram Navami with the Earth Saviour Foundation



Cosmo Foundation in association with the – 'Earth Saviour Foundation' celebrated Ram Navami with abandoned senior citizens and disabled inmates of Gurukul, located at Gurugram. Shri Ashok Jaipuria, Chairman and Managing Director, Cosmo Films limited and its employees helped and organized a special lunch for around 425 people residing in the locality. Looking at the need 15 air coolers were donated for the inmates.

2. Blood Donation Camp

Cosmo Foundation organised a Blood Donation Camp with the support of Rotary Blood Bank at Cosmo Films, New Delhi. Employees of Cosmo Films and many other enterprises at Jasola District Centre participated. The camp was inaugurated by Dr. Vivek Nangia, HOD & Director (Pulmunology), Fortis – Ranjan Dhall Hospital, New Delhi. A whopping number of 90 people from all corporate offices donated blood to the Rotary Blood Bank.



3. Woollen Distribution - Delhi & Karjan



Looking at the extreme cold condition in Northern India, Delhi employees collected unused woollens and Cosmo Foundation also procured some woollens. On the eve of Christmas these woollens were distributed to physically challenged senior citizen of the Earth Saviour Foundation, New Delhi. Similarly, at Chandra and Waluj Cosmo employees collected clothes & woollen blankets and Cosmo Foundation distributed the same. Tarun Gupta and Basant Mehta from Cosmo Films, Karjan and

Pravin Chauhan from Cosmo Foundation donated 40 blankets to tribal resident students in Methi Highschool.

4. Computer Lab upgradation and donation of desktop

Cosmo Films generously donated 185 desktops to Cosmo Foundation. 15 computer labs were upgraded through these desktops with electrification. 4 computer labs with LED screen, desktops, furniture, UPS and electrification were set up at Aurangabad.



CF Gifted Educational books to four students of 10th class

Cosmo Foundation gifted educational books (subject digest and practice workbook) to four high school girls of Choranda village, Karjan. These books were donated by Mr. Sagarbhai Patel, Assistant Manager, QA (quality assurance) Department, Cosmo Films Ltd. Mahi Parmar, Sona Parmar, Shivani Parmar and Arti Vasava from village Choranda benefitted.

5. Hygiene kits to 50 students on Christmas

Cosmo Foundation celebrated Christmas festival in Karamdi Primary School on the theme of cleanliness and hygiene. Chartered Accountant of Vadodara, Shri. Abhaybhai Sharma and Shri Divyeshbhai Trivedi from Duduz House with their family, Sarpanch and Anganwadi workers were present. Children performed nursery rhymes on Christmas. Ms. Mamta Baxi, Program Coordinator, Cosmo Foundation addressed and explained the importance of Christmas to the children and highlighted the hygiene habits and its daily practices. Cake and hygiene kits to children were distributed, which includes- handkerchief, comb, soap, oil and Vaseline. The children enjoyed the program by wearing Christmas costumes and raising awareness about hygiene.



6. 300 mattress to improve mid-day meal cleanliness at 20 Govt. schools

Cosmo Foundation and primary schools' teachers made a concerted effort to ensure children's hygiene practice on mid-day meals. Little efforts to improve children's practices were made viz. washing hands before and after lunch, sitting in lines, not wasting food and maintain cleanliness around them. In order to give more impetus to the schools and children in



this work, the Cosmo Foundation distributed 300 mattresses in 20 schools of Karjan Taluka. Additionally, soap and napkins for hand washing were also provided.

Financial Overview



The total cash expenditure of Cosmo Foundation during the year 19-20 was of the order of rupees 2.39 crores. All the above-mentioned cost was incurred towards arrangements of skilled teachers, curriculum, educational material and teaching aids, stationary assessments, training, planning, and monitoring of educational programs and organizing educational events.

This year Cosmo Foundation set up four computer labs in government schools of in Gangapur Block of Aurangabad District. The entire hardware including 100 sets of computers with LCD, furniture, license, software, UPS and electrification was provided. Entire expenditure is borne by Cosmo Foundation. In all 23 computer labs were setup across Karjan and

Aurangabad Internet Connectivity were given.

Apart from this, Cosmo Films provided office premises with equipment and hospitality. The company takes care of accounts, fulfillment of statutory requirements, and need based laptops and related equipment, which takes care of 30% expenditure.

Local schools provided premises to run the classes and hold training, electricity, setup computers, projector, security guard. This involves 20% expenditure.

The expenditure was incurred for supporting education of needy students, sponsoring Industrial Cricket Tournament and maintaining public garden at Aurangabad.

MIS (Management Information System) is being maintained for expenditure and progress output. There are internal and external audit, concrete monitoring by CSR committee and the trustee of Cosmo Foundation.
